### Minister's Musings

Dearly Beloved,

Truly, every time I think of you, dear church, I give thanks. For you are a source of hope and faithfulness and joy.

Yesterday, at our congregational meeting, we made the decision to sell our rental property at 832 N Lincoln Avenue. As someone said to me as we wrapped up our congregational meeting, it was a reminder that the church is indeed made up of its people – of all of you, all of us. There is no one person who can make decisions for us, but we make decisions together. We do not always agree, and there are some of us who did not vote to sell the building, and still we come together to live as best we can into God's world, serving and loving God's beloved community here in our congregation and well beyond.

Our theme for worship this summer is: "Growing in God's Love." Scripture is full of farming, growing, harvesting, and sowing imagery. Plants and fruit are used as metaphors for everything from the body of Christ to the fruits of the spirit. In scripture, we will find God as the gardener, in hymns God is the one who walks with us in the garden, and in parable God's kingdom is a seed.

We will use the image of a garden to ground us this summer – reflecting on seeds being planted, taking root, sprouting, growing, blooming and fruiting. Reflecting on the need for rest and rain, sun and soil, for toil and tending, for mulching and mowing. What seeds of faith, love or service have been sown in your life? What tending may they need to grow and flourish? What fruits of love and compassion are needed in our neighborhoods and communities? How can we plant seeds that might one day bear that fruit?

We hope that this theme will invite curiosity and delight all through the summer as many of us tend flowers, fruits and veggies as well as our own bodies, souls and spirits and the relationships that nourish us.

I hope and pray that you can feel God's love growing in you and in our congregation today and in the season to come!



## Chancel Mountain Mural

After we fell in love with the temporary foam board mountains requested by the 2019 spring worship team and created by Eunice Baer, there has been significant discussion around replacing those with a mural painted on the chancel wall behind the altar. You may have noticed that the foam-board mountains have been removed (they were not in great shape and posed a fire hazard) and that Pat and Brian Kukus have graciously repainted the blue behind the cross in preparation for a mural.

Daniel Gardner and Eunice Baer stepped forward and volunteered their artistic skill and expertise to create a proposal to share with our congregation for what that mural will look like. They have already invested considerable time and energy into this design.

On an upcoming Sunday morning, Eunice and Daniel will present this design in-person to the congregation. Then, we will schedule a congregational meeting on a following Sunday to vote on moving forward with this mural design.

### Some notes about the proposed mural:



Eunice Baer and Daniel Gardner selected colors drawing from tones in the stained glass windows and woodwork in our sanctuary. They also considered our liturgical colors: green, red and purple. Golds and yellows were intentionally placed at the level of the altar to draw out the gold designs in all of our paraments (the cloth that we place on our altar and pulpit).

Like our stained glass windows, the woodwork on our pulpit, altar and baptismal font, and the bronze statue in our narthex, this mural will add beauty and the gift of original art and craftwork to our worship space. It will remind us of God's presence and majesty within our building, within our beloved community and indeed in all of creation, especially the mountains where many of us experience God's presence and grace.
