### Minister's Musings

Dearly Beloved,

At the annual meeting of the Rocky Mountain Conference of the United Church of Christ in mid-June, we talked about the work of untangling and mending. You may know that things are a bit of a mess at the Conference level. In addition to having a brand new Interim Conference Minister (the Rev. Doug Wooten), and an almost entirely new Board of Directors, there is still much grief, confusion and anger about the November firing of Rev. Dr. Anthony Scott and the February resignation of long-time Senior Conference Minister Rev. Sue Artt. Emotions ran high at our gathering. Many of us believed we knew what was right and wanted others to agree with us. The fabric that weaves us together has been rent, torn, tangled, and frayed. Hurt, disappointment, distrust, tension and anger were palpable.

And into that space the Rev. Laura Everett of Mending Church invited us to see the work of untangling and mending as an act of devotion: of sacred work and love. When she had us tangle a skein of embroidery floss, I was reminded that trying to forcibly pull threads apart actually creates terrible knots. The more I pulled, the tighter and more tangled the thread became. I was reminded of the many times that my attempts at de-tangling are forced, rough, quick and lacking all gentleness or care. Though what I am trying to do is untangle, my attempts in fact make matters much much worse.

After creating this tangled mess, Rev. Everett instructed us to pass our embroidery floss to the person on our left. After all, we are often given the task of untangling knots that we ourselves did not make. This is the work of parenting. It is the work of living in community, of being humans together -- taking what we are handed and not simply cutting the thread into useless little snippets but gently, tenderly holding it. Finding an end and working that end back and through, back and through. Taking our time. Sometimes stopping to rest, to come back with a new sense of vision, with our fingers uncramped to work some more. Sometimes we do the best we can to untangle and then need to pass the knot on to someone with more experience or nimbler fingers or just a little more patience.

What in your life is tangled or torn?
What in our collective life? As a congregation? A community? A nation?
What is worthy of untangling? What is worthy of repair?

I am grateful to share space with you, to untangle, tend, repair and mend together. To be reminded that I am worthy of healing, wholeness and health. As are you, our neighbors, our church, our Conference and our world
